- Full-time student enrolled in a degree-conferring graduate program in psychology. Does not need to be a health psychology program.
- Current member of the Society for Health Psychology.
- For the **award promoting inclusion**, applicants must self-identify as being from an underrepresented group in biomedical and health psychology research.
 - e.g., individuals in racial / ethnic minority groups; individuals with disabilities; individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds
